

Super Simple Holiday Ornament

Looking for a quick gift idea? This one is handmade, heartfelt, and...oh, so cute!

Materials Needed:

Inky Antics Stamps**†

StazOn Ink Pad in Jet Black

2" x 2" White Mat Board

2" x 2" Red Cardstock

Prismacolor Pencils**

Gamsol Odorless Mineral Spirits**

Blending Stumps**

2" x 2" Ranger Memory Glass**, 1 pc.

Ranger Memory Copper Foil Tape**, 9 in.

Ultrafine Clear Glitter

Glue Pen

Mini Glue Dots, 6

Ribbon, 4 in.

Inky-structions:

1. Stamp image onto mat board with black StazOn pad, and color/blend using colored pencils and Gamsol.



Smooth edges with your fingers to create an even border around the Memory Glass and back of the mat board.



2. Use glue pen to apply ultrafine glitter liberally over the stamped image and other areas, and tap off excess.



4. Apply one glue to each corner of the back, and adhere the ribbon ends to the top two glue dots.



3. Lay Memory Glass on top of mat board, and wrap edges with Copper Foil Tape. As you go, remove the brown liner a little at a time, rather than all at once.

5. Place the red cardstock square on the back of the ornament. You're done!



Inky Tip: Omit the ribbon and put a magnet on the back to create a totally different item!
