

Snowy's Treats Paper Bag Card

Transform a plain brown paper lunch bag into this charming card that holds a packet of cocoa!

Materials Needed:

Inky Antics Stamps**

White Pigment Ink Pad**

Black Dye Ink Pad**

Coloring Supplies**

Stapler

Scissors

Double-Sided Tape

Ribbon

Cardstock in White, Light Blue & Dark Blue

Brown Paper Lunch Bag

Cocoa Packet

Inky-structions:

1. Fold the bottom/base flap of the paper bag in half, and use double-sided tape to adhere the "feet" of the bag together. Cut off corners at a 45-degree angle on both sides, up to the first fold (about 1 3/4" from bottom edge). Now fold the top of the bag down to match the edge of that first fold. You've just created the foundation of your card, which is ready to decorate.
2. Stamp two 4 1/4" x 4 7/8" pieces of light blue cardstock with 10163H Frosty Fun WordGround using white pigment ink. Also stamp bottom fold-up flap of paper bag with 10163H Frosty Fun WordGround.
3. Stamp 7/8" x 4 7/8" piece of dark blue cardstock with 0547D Frosty Friends Make using white pigment ink.
4. Stamp 2 1/8" x 2 7/8" piece of white cardstock with 10167H Snowy's Treats using black dye ink and color as desired. Layer onto 2 3/8" x 3 1/8" piece of dark blue cardstock.
5. Stamp 3/4" x 3" piece of white cardstock with 0560E Snow Friend Like using black dye ink. Layer onto 1" x 3 1/4" dark blue cardstock.
6. Adhere one of the light blue panels from step #2 onto front of card, and adhere the other panel to inside of card.
7. Adhere layered image panel onto blue piece of card front, and adhere layered saying panel onto blue piece of card inside.
8. Staple the dark blue strip from step #3 along the bottom of the card front, going through all the top layers (including the paper bag) and stapling as close to the edges as possible.
9. Open card, and insert packet of cocoa into pocket at top of card.
10. Fold the bottom flap upward and slip underneath the dark blue strip. You're done!
